**ORDER EXTENDING OR
MODIFYING CERTAIN
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
DEADLINES**

On April 2, 2020, Plaintiff Richard Behfarin and Defendants Pruco Life Insurance Company, The Prudential Insurance Company of America and Pruco Life Insurance Company of New Jersey filed their Stipulation Extending or Modifying Certain Settlement Agreement Deadlines. Upon due consideration, and GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, the following deadlines set forth in the Stipulation of Settlement and Release and related exhibits (“Settlement Agreement”) (ECF No. 74-1) are modified or extended as follows:

(1) Section VIII.H of the Settlement Agreement is modified to provide that the audit of the Scoring Process shall commence no later than thirty (30) days

1 following the latter of Final Approval or the Claims Deadline, instead of within
2 thirty (30) days of the commencement of the Scoring Process.


3 (2) Exhibits C and D of the Settlement Agreement are modified to provide
4 that the Claims Administrator shall complete review of the respective claims
5 submitted by Settlement Class Members in the Lapsed/Deceased and Lapsed/Alive
6 Populations within the latter of one hundred and twenty (120) days after the
7 Settlement becomes Final or the Claims Deadline, subject to (a) Claimants'
8 correction of any delinquencies, and (b) the completion of any Limited Appeal,
9 which may extend this time period.

10 (3) Exhibit C of the Settlement Agreement is modified to provide that the
11 Claims Administrator shall commence the process of sending notification letters
12 regarding Reinstatement Relief commencing no later than forty-five (45) days after
13 the Settlement becoming Final or forty-five (45) days after the Claims Deadline,
14 instead of commencing ten (10) days after the Settlement becomes Final.

15 (4) Section III.C.8 and Exhibit D of the Settlement Agreement are modified
16 to provide that the Claims Administrator shall issue checks to Settlement Class
17 Members as promptly as possible, but no more than sixty (60) days following the
18 Claims Administrator's completion of calculations of Settlement Payments for
19 individual Authorized Claimants, instead of no more than sixty (60) days following
20 the Settlement becoming Final.
